ABOUT TWO SQUARED

Two Squared wines began as inspiring expressions of the Napa Valley produced from lesser known, high-quality vineyards. The expanded portfolio now includes wines produced from other esteemed vineyards and regions throughout California. With the multitude of unique varieties and terroirs available to our winemakers, these limited production wines create a compelling winemaking journey that showcases California's ideal trinity of climate, soil and topography.

VINTAGE NOTES

A dry winter and cool spring delayed bud break and slowed bloom and fruit development. Warmer weather, however, prevailed through summer prompting an early harvest date of August 12. The early harvest and reduced yields, a result of drought conditions the last two years, have produced a very expressive vintage featuring concentrated flavors and bright acidity.

VINEYARD SOURCES

Grapes for this wine came from the historic Estrella District, one of the oldest growing regions in the Paso Robles AVA. Located in the northeast corner of the AVA, this area is known for its undulating landscape, alluvial soils and higher elevations. The name Estrella, or “star” in Spanish, was inspired by the interesting star-like pattern made by ridgelines that come together here.

WINEMAKING

The 2022 vintage is 100% Sauvignon Blanc. Grapes were whole cluster pressed and the juice was cold settled for four days before fermentation in 100% stainless steel tanks at cool temperatures. After fermentation, the wine was aged in 35% French acacia puncheons and 65% stainless steel tanks for five months.

Sight	Medium light gold with silver highlights
Nose	Aromas of ripe cantaloupe and lemon lime are accented by notes of fresh peas, chives, white flowers and celery.
Palate	This wine is medium bodied with fresh flavors of tangerine, white grapefruit and nectarine and lemongrass framed by lively acidity.
