Two Squared celebrates the inherent beauty of extraordinary pairings, that magical combination of grape and place. Our journey began in 2009 with a Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon based wine, Two Squared "Red" that showcases the discovery and collaboration with a remarkable collection of privately owned, boutique vineyards in the Napa Valley and has now expanded to the very best wine regions in the North and Central Coast of California as we continue our search for more of those perfect pairings.

## VINTAGE NOTES

Late winter rains followed by ideal spring growing conditions set the stage for the 2021 vintage. Mild temperatures punctuated this drought year with only a few heat spikes during the summer months that led to early ripening and allowed us to harvest some early blocks with incredible old-world charm and intriguing complexity. Grapes that were harvested later benefitted from the longer hang time and ripened perfectly, displaying great depth with distinct regional character. The ideal weather of 2021, coupled with lower yields, produced wines that offer intense aromatics and flavors with excellent aging potential.

## VINEYARD SOURCES

Over the years our winemaking team has discovered a number of "hidden gems", small, high-quality vineyards tucked away in the Napa Valley. Grapes for this wine came from a selection of these vineyards from different terroirs in the valley that includes a significant portion from the St. Helena and Oak Knoll AVA's.

## WINEMAKING

These hand-picked grapes ultimately created a wine that is 91% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Merlot, 3% Malbec and 2% Petit Verdot. Fermentation took place in stainless steel tanks followed by nine months of aging in French oak barriques of which 20% were new.

Sight Dark Ruby Red

Nose Fruit aromas of bramble berries, strawberry rhubarb pie and blueberry are intertwined

with notes of toasted grains, graphite, tarragon spice and blonde roast coffee.

Palate Medium bodied with exceptional balance, the assertive fruit flavors of cherry and

raspberry are further enhanced by notes of dry earth and toasted French oak.
